## LIGHT UP YOUR HEAD

With its combination of integrated lights, brake warning light and turn signals all in one, the Lumos helmet is easily the safest helmet on the market today. The helmet has front and rear lights that are powered from an internal battery. If a rider decreases speed quickly, the lights automatically increase brightness for a brake-light effect.

There is a wireless remote that can be mounted to the bars to function the right and left turn-signal effect. All of this means you get added security and visibility on the road. Sure, at 455 grams the Lumos is not touting itself as lightweight lid, but if being seen is your main prerogative, this helmet is unmatched.
